

WORKSHIP PROJECTS FOR MARCH 31, 2019

- 1. CHURCH STREET MINISTRIES (10 people) Mars Patterson – Gather in Lobby, then carpool to the Second Mile Shop at 1480 W. Bagley Road; 9:00-11:30:** This project will involve tasks like dusting, sweeping, organizing, polishing, and getting goods ready for sale at the Second Mile Shop and Food Bank for distribution to clients.
- 2. HOMEBOUND VISITATION (20 people) Rev. Erv Koch – Room 112, then homes of members; 9:00-11:45:** This project begins with a short training in the Conference Room where visitors will receive hints for a successful home visit and will review a printed communion service that can be shared during their visit. Pairs of visitors will then go out to bring our love and concern to homebound church members.
- 3. LUNCHEON (6 People) Mary Mayse & Patti Tekancic – Fellowship Hall; 10:30-1:30:** Help prepare a simple meal, set tables, serve, and clean up at the luncheon following our Workship projects. No cooking knowledge needed. Your leaders will give you all the instructions you need.
- 4. MESSAGES OF LOVE (20 people) Peg Knueve – Rooms 201-203; 10:00-11:45:** Design or decorate Easter Cards and make and decorate cardboard Easter Baskets to share with a friend or family member. Put your creativity to work...markers, stickers and instructions provided – no artistic ability required.
- 5. HANDMADE SHOWS WE CARE Project #1 (5 people) Amanda Zuelke – Room 204; 10:00-11:45:** Apply designs to fabric aprons given to new members when they “put on the apron to help us fulfill the mission of our church”. Materials and instructions provided – no artistic ability required, but steady hands needed.
- 6. HANDMADE SHOWS WE CARE Project #2 (15 people) Debbie Albany – Room 202; 10:30-11:45:** Decorate lunch size bags with markers, stickers and crayons and fill them with Easter treats for the clients at the Church Street Ministries Food Bank.
- 7. WELCOME FRIENDS (5 people) Mary Jecmen – Church Library; 10:30-11:45:** Prepare Welcome Bags for future visitors to our church and add your personal message to tell our visitors why they should come back to visit us again.
- 8. OUTREACH SINGING (20 people) Jarrod Sorauf – Gather in Choir Room 111, then travel to nursing home; 9:00-11:45:** All ages can sing for residents at a nursing home. This project always brings smiles to those who listen. A willing spirit and smiling face are required – you do not need to be able to read music or have an exceptional singing voice.
- 9. HANDY HELPER PROJECT #1 (2 people) Cheryl Seymour – Church Nursery; 10:30-11:45:** Lots of germs are around this winter. Help to dust the shelves and wash and disinfect the toys in the nursery in anticipation of lots of use by our youngsters. ALSO NEEDED, 1-2 PEOPLE TO HELP CHERYL WITH CHILDCARE.
- 10. HANDY HELPERS PROJECT #2 (6 people) John & Deb Thompson, Gary Canute – Gather in Parlor; 9:00-11:45:** Use your skills to help complete simple home repairs in the homes of our members as a Handy Helper. Simple skills include tasks like repairing leaky faucets, replacing light bulbs, caulking, or replacing electrical sockets – things that can be completed in a couple of hours. These projects will take place in the homes of members or at church.
- 11. WEEDS and SEEDS (10 people) Diana Stack – Gather in Lobby; 9:00-11:45:** Members who love to work outside are encouraged to sign up for this project so we can help beautify the yards of members and rid church gardens of winter debris. In inclement weather, the crew will help with some cleaning projects inside the church.
- 12. MEALS ON THE MOVE (6 people) Anne Harris – Kitchen; 8:30-10:30:** Meal will be made for St. Herman's in Cleveland's Ohio City which has served the poor and homeless for 35 years. In the past year they have served 73,000 hot meals to clients – three a day, seven days a week, all year. We will prepare a meal and deliver it to St. Herman's, but we need to have our food down to St. Herman's by 10:30 AM so this project will begin at 8:30 AM. HELP ALSO NEEDED SATURDAY IN CHURCH KITCHEN FOR PREPARATION
- 13. COMPANY'S COMING (10 people) Flo Thwaites – Fellowship Hall; 10:30-11:45:** In anticipation of people attending our services, learn how to prepare and serve communion and practice by setting up the table communion for our worship service after our March 31st Workship service projects.
- 14. DROP IN THE BUCKET (6 people) Robin Rush – Room 106; 10:30-11:45:** Sort, wash, and package pill bottles to be sent with medical equipment to third world countries and pack donations of men's clothing to be donated to St. Herman's.
- 15. ARCHIVES ORGANIZATION (3 people) Dick Berg – Church Archives Room 200; 10:00-11:45:** Help is needed to help organize files in the Church Archives. Ability to print legibly required.
